

Should one of the Contracting Parties send a delegation outside the framework of this Agreement, the concerned Contracting Party will pay all the relevant expenses.

#### ARTICLE 7

Compensation for any damage caused by military personnel during or in connection with their mission/exercise will be paid by the Sending Contracting Party.

If damage is caused to military personnel, equipment and infrastructure, any disputes between the Contracting Parties and compensation for damages will be settled by mutual agreement.

#### ARTICLE 8

The Host Party's Authorities are entitled to exercise their jurisdiction on visiting personnel as regards violations committed on the Host Party's territory that are offences under its legislation.

Nevertheless, the Authorities of the Sending Country are entitled to exercise their own jurisdiction on the members of their Armed Forces in the following cases:

- a. violations that threaten the security or property of the Sending Country;
- b. violations resulting from acts or omissions, committed intentionally or out of negligence in the performance of and in connection with service.

In the case at b. above, the Authorities of the Sending Country can waive their right to exercise jurisdiction by notifying such intention to the Host Country's Authorities and provided that the latter agree.

#### ARTICLE 9

The information exchanged under this Agreement shall be handled in accordance with the national rules of the Originating Contracting Party.
