

Activities, modalities, times and places will be specified in the above mentioned Programs.

ARTICLE 3

Cooperation between the Contracting Parties will take place in the following sectors:

- defense security and policy;
- defense industry and procurement policy which is subordinated by the Ministries of Defense;
- import, export and transit of armaments;
- peacekeeping and humanitarian operations;
- compliance with the international treaties on defense, security and arms control;
- armed forces organization, structure and equipment of military units, personnel management;
- formation/training;
- military police issues;
- environmental issues and pollution caused by military facilities;
- military medical service;
- military history;
- military sport.

Military co-operation will not be limited to the above mentioned sectors. Actually, the Contracting Parties will seek new co-operation fields of mutual interest.

ARTICLE 4

Co-operation between the Contracting Parties will develop as follows:

- meetings of the Ministers of Defense, Commanders in Chief, their deputies and other officials authorized by the Contracting Parties;
- exchange of experiences between the experts of the two Contracting Parties;
